sudden-acute onset OCD | motor & vocal tics | restrictive eating | anxiety attacks | behavioural regression | emotional lability | depression | suicidal ideation | joint pain | irritability | rage attacks | oppositional behaviour hyperactivity | sleep disturbance | fatigue | mood swings | urinary problems dramatic personality changes | psychosis | emotional lability motor & sensory sensitivity | oppositional defiance | brain fog
