IBA's 4th Annual 2 & 5 km Walk Steppin' Out for PANS PANDAS

Steppin' Out for PANS PANDAS is Inflamed Brain Alliance's (IBA) signature, family-friendly peer-to-peer fundraising event. In 2026, we anticipate bringing together **over 250 walkers** across Canada to raise vital awareness and funds for individuals and families impacted by *PANS and **PANDAS.

Launched in 2023 with over 110 walkers participating in person at **Calgary's Bowness Park**, and virtually across Canada, the event exceeded expectations in its inaugural year. We've since expanded to include one new in-person walk every year: **Mississauga** (2024); **Fredericton** (2025); with **Edmonton & Halifax** in 2026!

On Walk Day, our "Steppin' Outers" step out—literally and figuratively—by moving beyond their comfort zones in solidarity with those facing the devastating impacts of these brain disorders.

Funds raised support the growth of IBA's national programs that promote health, and advance awareness, education, and research.

How Funds are Being Used

Funds raised through Steppin' Out help IBA advance its mission by supporting:

- ❖ **National Accredited Conference Programming:**
Hosting Canada's second biennial national accredited conference focused on PANS PANDAS, bringing together researchers, clinicians, families, and advocates to share knowledge, foster collaboration, and advance improvements in care and understanding.
- ❖ **The Canadian PANS Registry:**
Supporting research, improving care, and advancing future treatments for Canadians with PANS/PANDAS through Canada's first national patient registry, launched by IBA in 2025.
- ❖ **Educational Webinars:**
Offering free, accessible learning opportunities with experts in medical, mental health, and lived experience.
- ❖ **Peer Support Programs:**
Connecting families across Canada to reduce isolation, share resources, and build advocacy skills.
- ❖ **Public Awareness Campaigns:**
Increasing national visibility through coordinated initiatives such as World PANS PANDAS Awareness Day, social media outreach, and leading the global #LightUp4PANS landmark lighting campaign.
- ❖ **Digital and Print Educational Resources:**
Developing plain-language guides, toolkits, and materials for families, educators, and health professionals.
- ❖ **Organizational Sustainability:**
Supporting the infrastructure and coordination required to deliver national programs, resources, and advocacy initiatives.
- ❖ **Collaborative Projects:**
Partnering with allied organizations, clinicians, and researchers to drive policy change and cross-sector engagement.

What are PANS & PANDAS?

PANS (Pediatric Acute-onset Neuropsychiatric Syndrome) and **PANDAS** (Pediatric Autoimmune Neuropsychiatric Disorders Associated with Streptococcal Infection) are neuroimmune conditions that can cause a sudden and dramatic onset of psychiatric, neurological, and physical symptoms.

In many cases, symptoms appear following an infection, illness, or other immune trigger, causing the immune system to mistakenly attack healthy brain tissue and create inflammation in the brain.

Common symptoms may include:

- Sudden onset OCD
- Severe anxiety
- Eating restrictions
- Motor or vocal tics
- Mood and personality changes
- Cognitive decline or difficulty at school
- Sleep disturbances
- Sensory sensitivities
- Urinary frequency
- Depression or emotional dysregulation

Symptoms can appear suddenly and severely, often leaving families searching for answers during a frightening and confusing medical journey.

Because awareness remains limited, many patients experience delays in diagnosis and treatment. Families often see multiple healthcare providers before receiving appropriate care and support.

Although symptoms commonly begin in childhood, PANS can affect individuals of various ages and may persist or relapse without proper treatment.

Inflamed Brain Alliance is working to improve awareness, education, support, research, and access to care for Canadians affected by PANS/PANDAS.
