1. Complete our secure CanadaHelps online form.
2. Sign the Letter of Direction generated by CanadaHelps.
3. Your broker transfers the securities.
4. CanadaHelps processes the donation, issues your tax receipt, and sends the proceeds to Inflamed Brain Alliance.

Donations made before the end of the calendar year can either be applied to taxes for the current year or carried forward for up to 5 years. Donation tax credits cannot exceed 75% of a person's net income in a given year, or 100% of their terminal return or the return for the year prior to their death.

CanadaHelps manages gifts of securities made to Inflamed Brain Alliance, including the transfer, liquidation, receipting, and distribution of the net proceeds.
